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10 Principles of Arya Samaj

- 1. God is the primary source of all true knowledge and all that is known by its means. (At the beginning of creation, nearly 2 Billion years ago, God gave the knowledge of 4 Vedas to four learned Rishis named Agni, Vayu, Aditya and Angira. Four Vedas called Rigved, Yajurved, Samved and Atharva Ved contain all true knowledge, spiritual and scientific, known to the world.)
- 2. God is existent, intelligent and blissful. He is formless, omnipotent, just, merciful, unborn, infinite, invariable (unchangeable), having no beginning, matchless (unparalleled), the support of all, the master of all, omnipresent, omniscient, ever young (imperishable), immortal, fearless, eternal, holy and creator of universe. To him alone worship is due.
- 3. Vedas are the scripture of all true knowledge. It is paramount duty of all Aryan to read them, teach and recite them to others.
- 4. All human beings should always be ready to accept the truth and give up untruth.
- 5. All our actions should be according to the principles of Dharma i.e. after differentiating right from wrong.
- 6. The primary aim of Arya Samaj is to do good to the human beings of whole world i.e. to its physical, spiritual and social welfare.
- 7. All human beings ought to be treated with love, justice and according to their merits as dictated by Dharma.
- 8. We should all promote knowledge (Vidya) and dispel ignorance (Avidya).
- 9. One should not be content with one's own welfare alone but should look for one's welfare in the welfare of all others.
- 10. In matters which affect the well being of all people an individual should subordinate any personal rights that are in conflict with the wishes of the majority. In matters that affect him/her alone he/she is free to exercise his/her human rights.

Meaning

The thought which shelters in my mind, is on low mindedness which hovers therein, I will drive away jealousy from my mind just as one releases hot air from the bellows.

Contemplation

Jealousy is an element of the mind which is the product of narrow mindedness. It is not practical to believe that every person will reach the same height in life. Every individual's effort is different. The capability of intellect is not the same and the circumstances of some are not favourable. Therefore some people are going to be ahead of others.

Now it depends on the flow of thoughts of our mind which way it turns. Elevation in human life is of four kinds i.e political, spiritual, educational and financial. When we see the rise of a person there are two types of reaction in our mind. One is positive and the other is negative. The positive is called a divine tendency and the negative is called a demon tendency.

Some take pleasure in the prosperity and rise of others. When they see that someone has achieved heights in the spiritual field. They think such people make the world more peaceful and they will raise the moral standard of the society, and the entire society will reap the benefit of their achievements.

When they see someone is honoured for his contribution to society, they feel delighted that it will stimulate others and they will enthusiastically engage in contributing to society. This type of flow of thought is called divine spirit. To cultivate the feeling of delight in the success and prosperity of others is a divine spirit.

On the contrary some will feel jealous when see others prosperous and successful. Jealousy means they do not tolerate the success, rise, prosperity or victory of others. Such people torture themselves for their own mentality. They suffer due to their narrow mindedness and this type of tendency leads to their downfall. Jealousy is afire and it burns those who foster it. Therefore get rid of this fire of jealousy.

१३ वाँ विवाह सँस्कार आचार्य डॉ. उमेश यादव

यह विवाह सर्वाधिक प्रसिद्ध है क्योंकि यह सँस्कार सभी गृहस्थ बनने वालों के लिये किसी न किसी रुप से अनिवार्यतः सम्पन्न करवाया जाता है। इसे गरीब-अमीर सभी बहुत ही उत्साहपूर्वक अपनी-अपनी सामर्थ्य के अनुसार मनाते हैं। वि-वाह= वि- विशेषता से वाह- वहन करना। गृहस्थ की जिम्मेवारियों को वाखूबी निभाने का व्रत-संकल्प है-विवाह। इस सँस्कार के माध्यम से होने वाले पित-पत्नी अपनी-अपनी जिम्मेवारियों को भिल-भाँति निभाने की प्रतिज्ञा करते हैं। महर्षि दयानन्द ने विवाह हेतु परस्पर तुल्य गुण-कर्म-स्वभाव का होना महत्त्वपूर्ण बताया है। श्रेष्ठ संतान की ईच्छा से जब मुख्य ध्येय बनाते हैं और फिर प्रीतिपूर्वक गृहस्थ धर्म के अनुसार एक विचार हो संसार में उत्तम कर्म करने के लिये स्त्री-पुरुष परस्पर विधिवत् सम्बन्ध बनाते हैं तब वह विवाह कहलाता है।

विवाह में आयु-विचार- इस वारे में हम गर्भाधान सँस्कार में विस्तार से वर्णन कर आये हैं। वाल-विवाह और किशोर विवाह तो वैदिक धर्म में वा कानूनन भी सर्वथा वर्जित है। युवा विवाह ही स्वीकार्य है। इसके लिये वैदिक धर्मानुसार न्यूनतन आयु पुरुष की २५ वर्ष और कन्या की १६ वर्ष मान्य है। यह बर-कन्या की शारीरिक संरचना व परिपक्वता के अनुसार आयुर्वेद आदि स्वास्थ्य-विचार मूलक ग्रन्थों के आधार पर बताया गया है। कानूनन कन्या न्यूनतम १८ वर्ष और वर २१ वर्ष का होना मान्य है। शारीरिक विकास की दृष्टि से शास्त्रीय प्रमाणों के आधार पर पुरुष ४८ वर्ष और कन्या २४ वर्ष का अधिकतम होना बताया गया जबकि वैधानिक दृष्टि

से कन्या १८ वर्ष और वर २१ वर्ष के वाद कोई किसी भी उम का हो ; परस्पर विवाह करने में कोई अड़चन नहीं है पर वैदिक ग्रन्थों के अनुसार यह स्पष्ट किया गया है कि कन्या वर की उम से कम उम की हो । यह गृहस्थ-अनुभव-सुख को ध्यान में रखकर कहा गया है । विस्तार ज्ञान के लिये आयुर्वेद, चरक और सुश्रुत जैसे स्वास्थ्य-औषधि-चिकित्सा मूलक ग्रन्थ पढ़ें ।

विवाह में लग्न-विचार- महर्षि दयानन्द ने विवाह काल में लग्न के लिये विवाह-मुहूर्त-काल, नक्षत्र- आदि विचार सर्वथा कल्पनायुक्त अवैदिक बताया है । महर्षि दयानन्द कृत सँस्कार विधि में उद्धृत आश्लायन १/४/१-२ तथा गोभिल्य गृहसूत्रों २/१/१-२ का प्रमाण देख सकते हैं ।

विवाह-प्रकार- मनुस्मृति के आधार पर महर्षि दयानन्द ने उल्लेख किया है कि विवाह आठ प्रकार का माना गया जिसमें प्रथम के चार उत्तम हैं और बाद के चार उत्तरोतर कम अच्छा हैं। इनके नाम हैं- ब्राहम, देव, आर्ष, प्राजापत्य प्रथम के चार एवं आसुर, गान्धर्व, राक्षस, और पैशाच ये बाद के चार । पूर्व के चार सँस्कार युक्त यज्ञ विधि से सम्पन्न किये जाते हैं और बाद के चार विवाह-प्रकारों में सँस्कारात्मक यज्ञ-विधा नहीं है, सम्भवत: इसी कारण बाद के इन चारों प्रकारों को कम अच्छा बताया गया है। यह भी सम्भव है कि आधुनिक काल में विवाह की कुछ ऐसी विधायें पायी जाती हैं जिनमें यज्ञ का समावेश नहीं है; यह इन्हीं प्रचलित चार विधाओं से ले लिया गया हो। उदाहरण के तौर पर हम पंजीकृत विवाह (सिविल मैरेज/ रजिस्ट्री मैरेज) की विधि । इनमें कुछ प्रतिज्ञायें तो हैं पर सँस्कारात्मक यज्ञ-विधान नहीं हैं। धार्मिक साम्प्रदायिक भाव से बचने के

लिये या विधि में सरलता दिखाने के लिये भी ऐसा किया जाना सम्भावित है। समयानुसार इन विधियों में परिवर्तन आता रहना भी सम्भव है, इस कारण ही यज्ञ विधि को स्मार्त-विधा कहा गया है। स्मार्त का अर्थ परिवर्तन ही होता है। समाज में कुछ धार्मिक हैं, कुछ नास्तिक हैं, कुछ बाहमण सभ्यता तो कुछ जंगली सभ्यता से प्रभावित लोग होते हैं जो सदियों से चले आ रहे हैं। कदाचित सँस्कारों पर भी इसका प्रभाव पड़ता रहा है। फिर भी मानव मूल्यों को सही ढंग से उभारने में यज्ञ-विधा सर्वोत्तम सिद्ध है। वैदिक धर्म /आर्य सँस्कृति / महर्षि दयानन्द सरस्वती का विचार सर्वथा आर्ष अर्थात् ऋषि-परम्परा के अनुरुप है। मानव जीवन को श्रेष्ठ बनाने में अनुकूल है। हमें इसका मान करना उचित है।

विवाह-सम्बन्ध में विशेष विचार- सगोत्र तथा निकट का विवाह अनुचित बताया गया। चचेरे, ममेरे, फुफेरे, मौसेरे जैसे भाई-बहनों में या ऐसे ही निकट के सम्बन्धों में विवाह करना निम्नलिखित कारणों से अनुचित है। निकट सम्बन्ध या स्थान होने पर प्रायः एक -दूसरे के गुण -दोष को निकट से जानते हैं फलतः एक-दूसरे के साथ उचित मर्यादा का पालन नहीं कर पाते। परस्पर प्यार की कमी रहती है। आवश्यक पित-पत्नी की मर्यादित दूरी का महत्त्व नहीं समझने के कारण आपसी कलह अधिक रहती है। आपसी प्रेम में भी कमी आ जाती है। कहावत है कि परोक्ष पदार्थ में जितनी प्रीति रहती है, उतनी प्रत्यक्ष में नहीं। निकट सम्बन्ध से स्त्री-पुरुष के पारम्परिक शारीरिक रोग (जेनेटिक डिजीज) बढ़ते हैं। संतान भी कम वुद्धिमान् और कम स्वस्थ होती है। इस प्रकार निकट के सम्बन्ध में कलह, अप्रीति, अवनित तथा निर्धनता की अवस्था उभरने की सम्भावना बनी रहती है। अतः हमें सगोत्र विवाह और निकट का विवाह

से बचना चाहिये । यथासम्भव दूरस्थानीय विवाह को महत्त्व देना उचित है । इसमें पति-पत्नी के बीच माता-पिता का टोक-टोकाव भी कम हो जाता है । बहुत सारे झगड़े तो बड़ों के टोक-टोकाव से ही जुड़े पाये जाते हैं । बड़ों का टोक-टोकाव न हो तो वे स्वयं अपने झगड़े कुछ कट् टे-मिट् ठे अनुभवों के आधार पर निबट कर गृहस्थ प्यार को बढ़ा लेते हैं । इससे उनका जीवन स्वयं ही सधता रहता है और परस्पर प्यार बना रहता है जो उनका प्रीति, उन्नति तथा ऐश्वर्य का मजबूत आधार बनता है । निरुक्त ३/४ का यह उदाहरण उपयुक्त है- " दुहिता दुर्हिता दूरे हिता भवतीति वा " अर्थात् कन्या का विवाह जितना दूर होवे ; उसके लिये उतना ही लाभप्रद है । इसके साथ यह भी ध्यान देना योग्य है कि उनके गुण-कर्म-स्वाभाव की परीक्षा जन्मना नहीं अपितु कर्मणा हो जिसमें वर-कन्या को पूरा अधिकार है कि वे एक-दूसरे की परीक्षा विना किसी झिझक के करें। किसी के दवाब में कभी न करें । दोनों की स्वेच्छा आवश्यक है । ध्यान रहे कि ब्राहमण-क्लोत्पन्न चरित्र अष्ट होकर गिर सकता है और शूद्र का वच्चा भी चरित्र से श्रेष्ठ बनकर ब्राहण बन सकता है या इसी प्रकार कोई अन्य वर्ण धर्म को प्राप्त हो सकता है। मन्स्मृति का यह प्रमाण हमें यही स्पष्ट कर रहा है । देखें-

"शूद्रो ब्राह्मणतामेति ब्राह्मणश्चैति शूद्रताम् । क्षित्रयाज्जातमेवन्तु विद्याद्वैश्यात्तथैव च " । अतः महर्षि दयानन्द ने स्पष्ट कहा कि अगर किसी व्यक्ति में ब्राह्मण का गुण है तो उसे ब्राह्मण का स्थान मानव समाज में मिलना चाहिये चाहे वह शूद्रकुलोत्पन्न ही क्यों न हो और वैसे ही शूद्र का गुण है तो उसे शूद्र का स्थान मिले चाहे वह ब्राह्मण कुलोत्पन्न ही क्यों न हो । इसे ही हम जन्मना नहीं बल्कि कर्मणा

मानना कहेंगे । तभी गुण-कर्म-स्वभाव को उचित स्थान मिल सकेगा ।

ब्राहमण-पहचान- महाभारत का यह प्रमाण देखें-

- १. सत्यं दानमथाद्रोह आनृशंस्यं त्रपा घृणा । तपश्च दश्यते यत्र स ब्राहमण इति स्मृतः ॥
- २. शूद्रे चैतद् भवेल्लक्ष्यं द्विजे तच्च विद्यते । न वै शूद्रो भवेच्छूद्रो ब्राहमणो न च ब्राहमण: ॥ महाभारत-शा. १८८.४.८

अर्थ- जिसमें सत्य, दान, अद्रोह, अक्रूरता, लज्जा, दया और तप दिखे, वह ब्राहमण है। यदि ये गुण शूद्र में दिखाई दे और ब्राहमण में नहीं तो शूद्र ही ब्राहमण है और ब्राहमण शूद्र है। अर्थात् गुण-कर्म-स्वभाव की प्रधानता से जो वर्ण-व्यवस्था आर्ष ग्रन्थों में है वही महर्षि दयानन्द को भी स्वीकार्य है। अतः विवाह प्रकरण में यह तो देखें कि ब्राहमण-ब्राहमणी, क्षत्रिय-क्षत्रिया, वैश्य-वैश्या/वैश्यधर्मिणी और शूद्र-शूद्रा का विवाह समुचित जाने पर यह सब गुण-कर्म-स्वभाव से मान्य है न कि कुल-जन्म से। इसमें आश्वलायन गृह-सूत्र १/५/५ का प्रमाण भी सहायक है। देखें- सं.वि. स्वामी दयानन्द सरस्वती।

विवाह-तिथि में विचार- जिस दिन दोनों का मन प्रसन्न हो और विवाह करने की प्रबल ईच्छा बन रही हो उस दिन ही करें । इसमें बहुत ही सटीक प्रमाण मिलता है कि जब कन्या रजस्वला होकर शुद्ध हो जाये तब उसी दिन या उसके तीन रात्री छोड़कर विवाह तिथि निर्धारित किया जाये । यह इस लिये कि विवाहोपरान्त गर्भाधान करने में सर्वथा अनुकूलता हो । इसी कारण उतर-विधि में यह कहा गया है कि विवाह के बाद तीन रात्री कम से कम दोनों प्रीतिपूर्वक मर्यादित रहकर ब्रह्मचर्य का पालन करें । तब

गर्भाधान सँस्कार को विधिपूर्वक सम्पन्न करें। आम भाषा में इसे लोकाचार विधि के अन्तरगत् चौठारी कहा जाता है। यह चौठारी कुछ और नहीं अपितु गर्भाधान सँस्कार करने की ही एक विधिवत् प्रक्रिया है। प्राय: यह देखा जाता है कि विवाह के बाद चौथे दिन लोग अपने घर पर यज्ञ, पूजा, कथा आदि आयोजन रखते हैं। वस्तुत: यह गर्भाधान सँस्कार का ही विकृतरुप है। हमें इस दिन विधिवत् गर्भाधान सँस्कार को ही सम्पन्न करना चाहिये फिर पति-पत्नी अपना मर्यादित गृहस्थ आरम्भ करें। विवाह-विधि की चर्चा अगले अंक में करेंगे।

We are still looking for a qualified Solicitor/Lawyer to join our team.


We had a very fruitful and positive meeting with members of Education department of Birmingham City Council this month.

GANDHI JAYANTI, 2 OCTOBER, 2015

Gandhi Jayanti is a national event celebrated every year to pay tribute to the Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi. This day is also celebrated as the International Day of Non-Violence all over the world. Gandhi Jayanti has been declared as International Day of Non-Violence by the United Nations General Assembly on 15th of June 2007. Gandhi Jayanti is observed as a national holiday all through the country in order to commemorate the birth anniversary of Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi (born on 2nd of October in 1869). His non-violence movement for independence of India is still continues influencing political leaders and youths of our own country as well as other countries worldwide.

The aim of celebrating Gandhi Jayanti as the International Day of non-violence is to distribute Bapu's philosophy, believe in nonviolence, principle, etc all over the world. It is celebrated through theme based proper activities in order to enhance the public awareness worldwide. Gandhi Jayanti celebration involves commemorating Mahatma Gandhi's life and his contributions in India's Independence. He was born in a small coastal town (Porbandar, Gujarat) however he performed great works all through his life which still influences the people in advance era.

He worked great for achieving Sawaraj, remove untouchability from society, abolition of other social evils, improving economic condition of farmers, empowering women rights and many more. The movements run by him are non-cooperation movement in 1920, Dandi March or Salt Satyagraha in 1930 and Quit India Movement in 1942 in order to help Indian people in getting freedom from British rule. His Quit India Movement was a call to British to leave India. Gandhi Jayanti is celebrated in various innovative ways by the students, teachers, government officials, etc all over the country. It is celebrated at Raj Ghat, New Delhi by offering flowers on Gandhi's statues, singing his favorite devotional song "Raghupati Raghava Raja Ram" and other ceremonial activities by the government officials.

It is one of the three National Holidays of the country (other two are Independence Day and Republic Day) celebrated every year in the schools, colleges, educational institutions, government and nongovernment organizations, etc. Schools, colleges, government offices, post offices, banks, etc remain closed on Gandhi Jayanti in order to pay tribute to the great leader of India. We remember Bapu and his great deeds by celebrating the Gandhi Jayanti. Students are assigned for various tasks to perform at this day such as poem or speech recitation, drama play, essay writing, slogan writing, group discussion, etc based on the life and works of Mahatma Gandhi.
