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10 Principles of Arya Samaj

- 1. God is the primary source of all true knowledge and all that is known by its means. (At the beginning of creation, nearly 2 Billion years ago, God gave the knowledge of 4 Vedas to four learned Rishis named Agni, Vayu, Aditya and Angira. Four Vedas called Rig Ved, Yajur Ved, Sam Ved and Atharva Ved contain all true knowledge, spiritual and scientific, known to the world.)
- 2. God is existent, intelligent and blissful. He is formless, omnipotent, just, merciful, unborn, infinite, invariable (unchangeable), having no beginning, matchless (unparalleled), the support of all, the master of all, omnipresent, omniscient, ever young (imperishable), immortal, fearless, eternal, holy and creator of universe. To him alone worship is due.
- 3. Vedas are the scripture of all true knowledge. It is paramount duty of all Aryan to read them, teach and recite them to others.
- 4. All human beings should always be ready to accept the truth and give up untruth.
- 5. All our actions should be according to the principles of Dharma i.e. after differentiating right from wrong.
- 6. The primary aim of Arya Samaj is to do good to the human beings of whole world i.e. to its physical, spiritual and social welfare.
- 7. All human beings ought to be treated with love, justice and according to their merits as dictated by Dharma.
- 8. We should all promote knowledge (Vidya) and dispel ignorance (Avidya).
- 9. One should not be content with one's own welfare alone but should look for one's welfare in the welfare of all others.
- 10. In matters which affect the well being of all people an individual should subordinate any personal rights that are in conflict with the wishes of the majority. In matters that affect him/her alone he/she is free to exercise his/her human rights.

Anarvam = in the sky ocean

Visva = all

Anyah = child in the form of sun

Bhuvana = region of universe

Vicaste = illuminates

Rtun = seasons

Anyah = child in the form of moon

Viddhat = making

Jayase = rises

Punah = again.

Meaning

Moving one after the other by invisible force, these two playful children reach to the ocean. One of them illuminates all the universe and the other making the seasons.

Contemplation

In the sky ocean two children, sun and moon through invincible power of God rise one after other as they are playing. Having the unique redness the child (in the form of sun) starts peeping in the east. Then gradually, changing itself rising above and above reaches in the middle of sky and presents itself in full splendor. After that coming downwards playing like a child, again getting red shines in the west. When it stops its play, when it comes down then the moon in the form of a child appears in the sky. The moon with its tender, loving and smiling with its charm, cool, calm extending its moonlight moves from east to west. These two have their own charm. It appears that one sun is watching all the planets of the universe. When it opens the eyes, it is manifesting the universe. The second, moon creates seasons and months.

होम से उपकार स.प्र.३४५ पृ.

" देखो ! जहाँ होम होता है वहाँ से दूर देश में स्थित पुरुष के नासिका से सुगन्ध का ग्रहण होता है वैसे दुर्गन्ध का भी । इतने से ही समझ लो कि अग्नि में डाला हुआ पदार्थ सूक्ष्म होके फैल के वायु के साथ दूर देश में जाकर दुर्गन्ध की निवृत्ति करता है । अग्नि ही का सामर्थ्य है कि उस वायु और दुर्गन्धयुक्त पदार्थों को छिन्न-भिन्न और हल्का करके बाहर निकालकर पवित्र वायु का प्रवेश कर देता है ।

होम न करने से पाप

जिस मनुष्य के शरीर से जितना दुर्गन्ध उत्पन्न होके वायु और जल को बिगाड़ कर रोगोत्पित्ति का निमित्त होने से प्राणियों को दु:ख प्राप्त करता है उतना ही पाप उस मनुष्य को होता है । इसिलये उस पाप के निवारणार्थ उतना सुगन्ध वा उससे अधिक (सुगन्ध) वायु और जल में फैलाना चाहिये । और खिलाने-पिलाने से उसी एक व्यक्ति को सुख विशेष होता है । जितना घृत और सुगन्धादि पदार्थ एक मनुष्य खाता है उतने द्रव्य के होम से लाखों मनुष्यों का उपकार होता है । परन्तु जो मनुष्य लोग घृतादि उत्तम पदार्थ न खावें तो उनके शरीर और आत्मा के बल की उन्नित न हो सके । इससे अच्छे पदार्थ खिलाना-पिलाना भी चाहिये । परन्तु उससे होम अधिक करना उचित है, इसिलये होम करना आवश्यक है ।

नित्यकर्म अवश्य करें

नित्य कर्म करने में अनध्याय (अन्+अध्याय= न अध्याय) नहीं होता । जैसे श्वास-प्रश्वास सदा लिये जाते हैं; बन्द नहीं किये जा सकते , वैसे नित्य कर्म प्रतिदिन करना चाहिये, न किसी दिन छोड़ना, क्योंकि अनध्याय में भी अग्निहोत्रादि उत्तम कर्म किया हुआ पुण्यरुप होता है, जैसे झूठ बोलने में सदा पाप और सत्य बोलने में सदा पुण्य होता है वैसे ही बुरे कर्म करने में सदा अनध्याय और अच्छे कर्म करने में सदा स्वाध्याय ही होता है।

अग्निहोत्र के निन्दक धूर्त्त

अग्निहोत्रादि यज्ञों से वायु, वृष्टि, जल आदि की शुद्धि द्वारा आरोग्यता का होना, उससे धर्म, अर्थ, काम और मोक्ष की सिद्धि होती है । उसको न जानकर वेद, ईश्वर और वेदोक्त धर्म की निन्दा करना धूर्त्तों का काम है ।

होम का प्रचार

इसिलए आर्यवरिशरोमणि महाशय, ऋषि, महर्षि, राजे, महाराजे लोग बहुत सा होम करते और कराते थे । जब तक होम करने का प्रचार रहा तब तक आर्यवर्त्त देश रोगों से रहित और सुखों से पूरित था । अब भी प्रचार हो तो वैसा ही हो जाये ।

PANCHMAHAYAJNA UNDERSTANDING & METHOD OF DOING THESE

Part 2

2. Knowledge (Science) Of Creation (Shristi Vigyaan)

To destroy sin- In this section one gains knowledge about Creation.

In following Mantras the thought of natural, inherent and unrefined truth becomes relevant. One comes to know the value of Tap (tolerance, self-mortification, austerity). Almighty God is the cause of Creation of this universe. Almighty God has created Sea, Ocean, Day and Night, Sun, Moon, Earth, Sky, Outer Space (The near-vacuum extending between the planets and stars) where Sun, Moon and Stars are situated. When a person thinks about these creations he/she is bound to realise the existence of Almighty God. Our knowledge about Almighty God helps us to keep away from all kinds of sinful acts. When we go in to depth of various attributes and supreme quality of Almighty God then we also come to know the attributes of various matters (substances) of the Creation. With the help of such knowledge we try to use various matters of this Creation in a proper way which is friendly to our environment. This also helps us to live a healthy life style and stay away from committing any sinful act. This is what is called Aghmarshan (To crush sin).

3. Knowledge (Science) of Mind, Psychology and Day to Day things in Life

Going Round Mind- In this ceremony one has to recite six Mantras. One has to take his/her Mind in East, South, West, North, Down/Centre, Above and then one has to think (Contemplation) about the true meaning and feeling of these Mantras. With help of these Mantras one has to know about attributes and defects of these directions. This knowledge helps a person in his/her behaviour in day today life. This is the true meaning of these Mantras. God has created all these directions. A person with a sacramented Mind and with knowledge about attributes/defects of all these directions choose to use this knowledge and progresses towards living a virtuous life. This knowledge also helps a person to stay away from crookedness and makes one mentally strong and stay away from negative thoughts and nurture positive thoughts and actions in life. A worshiper of God always pays to Almighty God to remove/burn all negative and opposite thoughts from his/her Mind. In all six Mantras "Yoasmaam Dwesti Yam Vayam Dwishmastam **Vo Jambhe Dadmaah."** is repeated. The meaning of this is "Those people who are jealous of me or I am jealous of some one O Almighty God please destroy all these crooked (perverse) thinking from us by crushing these in between your divine and sharp jaw. This prayer is to help a person to get rid of malice (ill will) and create a Mind for good behaviour with other human beings. This is why it is called Knowledge of Mind and practical use of this knowledge in our day to day life.

4. Knowledge (Science) of Almighty God (Brahma Gyaan)

To sit near Almighty God (Upsthaan) - Udhyam tamsaspari Swah Pashyant Utaram - and other Mantras afterwards and up to Gaayatri Mantra are all known as Upasthaan Mantras. When reciting these Mantras the devotee (Adorer) of Almighty God completely gets immerses in the true meaning and sentiment of these Mantras and feels himself/herself very near to Almighty God. This is why this section is called Upsthaan. A human being should first know all about Creation (Srishti) from Prakriti (Matter) and his/her senses and then to know about and sit near Almighty God is the essence of Upsthaan.

While reciting these Ved Mantras a devotee becomes so much engrossed (Absorbed) in Almighty God that his/her all Cognitive Senses like Eyes, Ears, Speech, Hearing and Hearing and four aspects of Soul like Mind (Man), Intellect (Budhi), Heart (Chit) and Self Conscience (Ahamkaar) become pure and free of any kind of sin or blemish. With help of these Mantras a human being leads a successful life which is full of all correct and acceptable behaviour in his/her life and prays to Almighty God for 100 years of life span with all his/her senses in healthy and working order so that he/she can live a active and working life. One can pray for even more than 100 years of life but being healthy and independent without being a burden upon any one. He/she also prays to Almighty God to stay away from mental depression, hopelessness and any other kinds of mental weaknesses. He/she should not fall prey to negative thoughts/behaviour. He/she should move forward and progress in his/her life with full force with help of belief in Almighty God (Prabhu Vishwaas), Self Confidence (Atma Vishwaas) and confidence in his /her actions or deeds (Karma Vishwaas). By reciting Gaayatri Mantra again and again he/she should remember the Omnipotent, Creator of Universe, Blissful, Making this universe full of light Almighty God and always try to keep himself/herself closer to Almighty God. All these prayers and practices help a person to be blessed by a strong Mind and intellect to face any difficult situation in his/her life in future.

To Submit one self to God (Samarparna) - Under procedure of Sandhyopaasaanam the following writing is the true inner feeling of Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati. In this we can read and feel the total surrender (Samarparna) of Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati to the Almighty God. The following prayer is written by himself. By reading this one feels as though Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati is

in total assimilation and talk with Almighty God. The following words come out of his mouth spontaneously

"He Ishwar Dayaanidhe! Bhawatkripayaaanenajapoupaasanaadikarmanaa Dharmaarthakaammokshaanaanam Sadyah Sidhirbhavennah:."

This literally means 'O The Ocean of kindness Almighty God! With mercy of Yours and my deeds of praying and pious actions help me to achieve the highest fulfilment of human life of Dharma, Wealth (Artha), Enjoyment of legitimate desires (Kaam) and Salvation (Moksha) straight way.

Our existence on this earth should have a purpose. In order to live a fulfilling, happy and healthy life we should follow the teachings of Vedas. Towards the end of his masterpiece book "Satyarth Prakash" Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati wrote "A statement of My Beliefs". Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati has written very clearly the true meanings of Dharma, Artha, Kama and Moksha. These are as following.

DHARMA- The practice of fair and impartial justice together with that of truthfulness in word, deed and thought and the like- in a word, that which is in conformity (agreement) with the will of God, as written in Vedas- even that I call Dharma. But the practice of that which is NOT free from partiality and injustice as well that of untruthfulness in word, deed and thought- in a word that which is opposed to the will of God, as embodied in Vedas, even that I call Adharma.

ARTHA- The righteously (morally right or justifiable) and honestly acquired wealth alone constitutes Artha while that which is acquired by foul means is called Anarth.

KAMA- The enjoyment of legitimate desires with the help of honestly acquired wealth constitutes Kama.

MOKSHA- The freedom of soul from pain and suffering of every description and subsequent career of freedom in the all pervading God and his immense creation for a fixed period of time and its resumption of earthly life after the expiration of that period constitutes Moksha (salvation).

The means of salvation are the worship of God, in other words, the practice of Yoga, the performance of righteous deeds, the acquisition of true knowledge by the practice of Brahmacharya, the society of wise and the learned (Satsang), love of true knowledge, purity of thought and life of activity and so on.

Only a person with full devotion towards Almighty God can pray with such a total confidence in himself/herself. This is why it is known as **Samparparna Vidhi (To submit one self to God.)**

Namaskaar- Towards the end Namaskaar Mantra "Om Namah Shambhavyaay Cha Mayobhavaaya Cha. Namah Shankraay Cha Mayaskaraaya Cha. Namah Shivaaya Cha." appears. In this Mantra pure form of salutation (bow) is expressed by a devotee of Almighty God.

A devotee of Almighty God accepts the vast powers (Omnipotent) of his/her Almighty God and vows to His Glory. That Almighty God is alone the well wishers of all and inspires and encourages us to do noble deeds. Almighty God is the symbol of Truth (Satyam), Auspicious and Beneficial (Shivam), Beautiful and Graceful (Sundaram). He encourages us to be truthful in our thought, deed and action and takes way our pain and sorrow and Lord of all true knowledge. By bowing in front of Almighty God a devotee loses his/her arrogance and follows only the path of truth. He/she totally dedicates every thing in life to Almighty God and lives the rest of his/her life in happiness and bliss under protection of Almighty God. This is what called Samarparna and Sandhyopaasanam.
