## **A MESSAGE FROM CHAIRMAN**

Since beginning of Corona Virus Pandemic (Covid-19) in early March 2020 in UK we all are going through this horrible period of Lockdown, Social distancing, frequent hand washing and face covering. The activities of our Arya Samaj has been very badly affected by this pandemic.

Since 16th March 2020 we have been unable to hold our every Sunday Congregation (Satsang) and no Day Centre on every Wednesdays. This situation is still carrying on even today. Our learned Acharya Umesh Yadav has not been invited to perform Sacraments in the houses of our community members except Cremation Ceremonies. In this period we lost one of our very dedicated, sincere and hard working Life Member of Arya Samaj West Midlands Shri Harish Malhotra on 10th April 2020. He was cremated on 24th April 2020 with full Sanskar Vidhi rituals performed by Acharya Umesh Yadav. It is so unfortunate that due to Covid-19 restrictions only immediate family members were allowed to attend his cremation.

This year we have not been able to celebrate Foundation Day of Arya Samaj Movement, Independence Day of India with total enthusiasm and pomp and show. We were unable to hold our Month of July Annual General Meeting this year like past years and Annual Function of "Gayatri Maha Yajna". We will miss Diwali Celebration on 14th November 2020.

Due to cancellation of our main events this year and inability to hold our every Sunday Congregation (Satsang) our Arya Samaj is making a big financial loss. Fortunately some of our devoted members are donating regular money by Standing orders and some occasional donations by our esteem members.

In August/September 2020 a Letter "APPEAL FOR EMERGENCY FUNDING" was posted on my behalf regarding funding needed to deal with unstable upper part of tower in front of our Arya Samaj

Bhavan. I am happy to inform you that some of our generous members have donated money for this cause. Till now we have collected about £9000.00. You will read the names of these donors in another section of this bulletin. I am very grateful to all these donors.

There have been some positive developments in this period. Acharya Umesh Yadav and I have been able to concentrate on discussing and writing a book about "80% Contribution of Arya Samaj Movement in gaining independence of India from British Rule". This book is ready to be sent to Delhi for printing. The other good development has been about "Sandhya and Havan" performed by Acharya Umesh Yadav ji on every Sunday from 11am till 12pm in our Arya Samaj Yajna Shala since 5th April 2020. Quite a few of us join Acharya ji with Zoom Conference facility.

I would like to express my gratitude towards Acharya Umesh Yadav, his wife Mrs. Shanti Yadav and his family members and a member of Board of Trustees Mr. Vijay Kumar and his family for regularly performing this service every Sunday without exception. Now I am requesting to our members to join Acharya ji on some Sundays if possible.

We were successful to celebrate Ved Katha on "Science in Vedas (Vedoin Mein Vijnan)" from 3rd August 2020 till 10th August 2020 by our learned Acharya Umesh Yadav. A good number of us, young and old, joined Acharya ji via Zoom.

The Board of Trustees members and our Manager Miss Lisa Chauhan have worked to improve the quality of sound and picture and continuity of Zoom Conferencing facility and it will be a regular facility to cover most of events held in our Arya Samaj in future.

## वेदों में विज्ञान-१०

आचार्य डॉ. उमेश यादव

### समुद्र में नानाविध औषधियाँ

जैसा कि वर्णन आता है कि पृथिवी में मित्र व वरुण दो शक्तियाँ काम करती हैं जो साकारात्मक (पोजिटिव) और नाकारात्मक (नेगेटिव) हैं जिससे पृथिवी की रक्षा में सहायक है। उर्वी-- रक्षमाना ----मित्रा साथेवरुणोडास्वन्तः- ऋग्वेद-५.६२.५ के अनुसार

हम ऐसा ही समझते हैं कि ये दो शक्तियाँ पृथिवी की सुरक्षा व सन्तुलन बनाये रखने में अत्यन्त उपयोगी हैं। इसी तरह पृथिवी की शिराओं की बात बृहत् संहिता-दकार्गलाध्याय १.४ में कहा गया है कि जैसे मनुष्य के शरीर में नाडियाँ हैं जिनमें रक्त-प्रवाह होता है, इसी तरह पृथिवी में ऊँची -नीची ऐन्द्री, आग्नेयी आदि आठ शिरायें हैं और मध्य में नवमी शिरा है जिसका नाम महाशिरा है और इन्हीं से सैकड़ों शिरायें निकली हैं। ये सब शिरायें ही भूमंडल की वृक्ष-वनस्पतियों को सींचने में सहायक है वैसे ही जैसे माली नालियों से बागिचा सींचता है, मनुष्य शरीर या अन्य प्राणियों के शरीर में भी नाडियों द्वारा रक्त प्रवाह होता है जिससे शरीर स्वस्थ व सक्रिय रहा करता है। प्रमाण- दकार्गलं येन जलोपलब्धिः पुंसां तथांगेषु शिरास्तथैव क्षितावपि प्रोन्नतनिम्नसंस्थाः। दिक्पति संज्ञा च शिरा , नवमी मध्ये महाशिरा

नाम्नी । एताभ्योऽन्याः शतशो विनिः सूता नामभिः प्रथिताः ॥ इसी तरह पृथिवी का सम्बन्ध समुद्र से भी है जिसका सीधा सम्बन्ध प्राणियों के जीवन पर पड़ता है । यह तो हमने समझा ही कि पृथिवी, समुद्र आदि में गैस है जिसका उपयोग जन जीवन में विज्ञान की सहायता से लिया जाता है, ठीक उसी प्रकार समुद्र व पृथिवी में नानाविध औषधियाँ भी वेसुमार भरी पड़ी हैं । वैज्ञानिक इसकी खोज करते रहते हैं और उसका हित में जन-जीवन में होता रहता है । अभी हम सामुद्रिक औषधियों की बात करते हैं -

ऋग्वेद ८.२०.२५- यत्सिन्धुं यदसिकन्यां यत् समुद्रेषु मरुतः सुबर्हिषः । यत्पर्वतेषु भेषजम् । यहाँ सिन्धु और असिकनी (चेनाब) नदी की बात कही , उनमें औषधियाँ हैं, वैसे ही समुद्रों व पर्वतों में भी औषधियाँ प्राप्त हैं । चिकित्सक इन्हीं सूत्रों का सहारा लेकर समुद्र, नदी, पर्वत आदि से खास-खास पदार्थ , जड़ी-बूटी प्राप्त करते हैं और उनके गुण-दोष का परीक्षण कर मानव व अन्य प्राणियों की रक्षार्थ अनेक प्रकार की औषधियाँ तैयार कर पाते हैं । अथर्ववेद २.३.५ का यह मंत्र समझें-

उपजीका उपभरन्ति समुद्रादधि भेषजम् ।  
तदासावस्य भेषजं तदु रोगमशीशमत् ॥

यहाँ सामुद्रिक मिट्टी से रक्त-प्रवाह की चिकित्सा की बात कही जा रही है । समुद्र से प्राप्त मिट्टी से उपजीका अर्थात् रक्त प्रवाह के लिये प्रयोग कर जीवन प्रदान किया जाता है । यह “आसावस्य भेषजम् ” रक्तप्रवाह की औषधि होकर अनेक रोगों का निवारण करता है । जैसा कि कहा-रोगमशीशमत्- रोगनिवारक है ।

इसी तरह पृथिवी पृथिवी के गर्भ से एक मिट्टी निकलती है जो घाव भरने में काम आती है -- अरुसाणमिदं महत् पृथिव्या अद्युद्भृतम्- पृथिवी के अन्दर से निकली

मिट्टी के लेप से घाव भर जाता है। यह एक घाव का मानो मरहम है।

अथर्ववेद में तो सामुद्रिक शंख पर एक सुक्त ही है जिसमें समुद्र से निकले कई प्रकार के शंखों की बात कही गयी जिससे नाना प्रकार की दवाइयाँ बनायी जाती हैं अथवा बनायी जा सकती हैं।

समुद्राज्जातो मणिः - अथर्ववेद-४.१०.५, शंखो नो विश्वभेषजम्- ४.१०.३,  
देवानामस्थि कृशनं बभूव ।- ४.१०.७

समुद्र का उत्पन्न शंख मणि रूप है और ये मणियाँ-मोतियाँ भस्मरूप बनकर या सीधा आभूषण रूप में भी मानव हित में काम आती हैं। यह निश्चित रूप से विश्व की औषधि है। देवताओं की अस्थि/हड्डी है। ये सारे शंख औषधिरूप में दीर्घायु, तेज, बल, वृद्धि वर्धन के लिये उपयोगी हैं। ऋग्वेद १.१०४.३ में कहा गया कि सामुद्रिक फेन से वज्र बनता है। इन्द्र के वज्र को भी समुद्र के फेन से बना माना जाता है। इस फेन को किसी खास अवस्था में एक तापमान पर रखने से इसमें इतनी मजबूती आ जाती है कि इससे वज्र बनाया जा सकता है। “ भरते फेनमुदन्” ऋग्वेद और इसी तरह अथर्ववेद २०.२९.३ में भी कहा गया- अपां फेनेन नमुचेः शिर इन्द्रोदवर्तयः। सामुद्रिक फेन से बने वज्र से ही इन्द्र ने वृत् के शिर काटा था।

इन सब प्रमाणों से हम समझ सकते हैं कि वेद ज्ञान-विज्ञान के मौलिक संकेतों/सूत्रों से भरापड़ा है। वेद ज्ञान भी समुद्र जैसा ही अथाह ज्ञान का मानो समुद्र ही है। हमें ऐसे ज्ञानस्रोत वेदों के ज्ञान से लाभ लेना चाहिये जिससे हर पल सुखमय जीवन की सफलता सम्भव है।

I came to know Harish ji well since 1995 when we bought the headquarter for Arya Samaj (Vedic Mission) West Midlands in Nichells, Birmingham.

When I became President of Arya Samaj in July 2000 I requested Harish ji to join me as a member of Executive Committee and then as a Treasurer. Harish ji remained in Executive Committee till 31st July 2016. As a treasurer he presented Annual Accounts at AGM held on 31st July 2016.

He was Vice President in year 2012-13. After year 2016, in spite of me requesting Harish ji several times to join the Board of Trustees again he never agreed. His reply used to be "Narendra Ji I am a Sanyasi (saint) now. I can not take any post but my remaining life will be totally dedicated for the service of our Arya Samaj. This is what exactly happened.

Harish ji never wanted to come forward to have his photos taken with other committee members.

On some occasions I had to send some one to bring Harish ji forward so that I could pay tribute to him for his real hard work he was doing in the back ground.

Harish ji was a very important member of Management team for holding Matrimonial get to gathers. He took care of prizes and raffle tickets for big Diwali Celebrations and Charity Dinners.

**When he was in Birmingham he was the first person to reach Arya Samaj for Sunday congregation and help our Acharya ji getting things ready for Havan. He served Havan Samagri to**

**people doing Havan and towards the end he would take Havan Kund out side the hall. Then he will help out in serving Rishi Langar.**

**Harish ji helped Acharya Umesh ji to settle in UK when he arrived from India in 2005 and Office Manager Miss Lisa Chauhan to settle in her job.**

Harish ji designed a Donation Box for people to take home and collect money in it for our Arya Samaj. He took these boxes to homes of people connected with Arya Samaj..

**Harish ji was a very big contributor to all Arya Samaj events, small or big, physically and mentally. He was a true Nishkaam Sevak of Arya Samaj West Midlands. He never desired any reward from Arya Samaj in return. He just helped and helped his Arya Samaj physically, socially and financially by giving large donations from his own pocket and selling tickets for Charity Dinner events. He believed in philosophy of “What can I do for our Arya Samaj?”**

**His contribution to his Arya Samaj, from administrative, spiritual and financial points of view, was enormous. He was a very true Sevak of Arya Samaj West Midlands. He was back bone of Arya Samaj West Midlands. It will not be easy to replace Harish ji.**

When we moved to new premises of Arya Samaj at Rookery Road Harish ji worked very hard along with rest of us to get the building ready for inauguration on 29th April 2018. More than 300 people attended this event. He was a very important member of the welcome group for this event.


